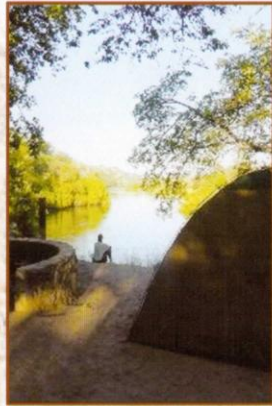


Hippo Pools Campsite

How to get there

From Oshakati: Take the C 46 main road to Ruacana. From the turn-off to the village of Ruacana it is about 17 km to the falls. Once you have passed the junction to the Ruacana border post, you drive on for another 4 km. Hippo Pool Campsite is on your right, just 200 m behind the hydroelectric power station, where the DR 3700 forks off from the C 46. From Epupa: Take the DR 3700 gravel road to Ruacana. The campsite is located at the junction of the DR 3700 and the C 46 tarred road.

- Services of trained local guides.
