
he Department of Wildlife and National Parks wishes to inform all its valuable customers that it does no longer accept payments of park fees at entrance gates to all our national parks and game reserves with effect from 1st January 2009.



Visitors to our national parks and game reserves (Chobe National Park, Moremi Game Reserve, Makgadikgadi/Nxai Pans National Parks, Central Kalahari Game Reserve, Khutse Game Reserve and Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park) can now pay all park fees in advance at central pay points as follows;

Gaborone, Tsabong, Ghanzi, Kang, Letlhakane, and Francistown Wildlife Offices which are open from 0730 hrs to 1630hrs and are closed during lunch hour (1245 to 1345), weekends and holidays.

Maun Reservations Office which operates from 0730 to 1630 (Monday to Saturday), 0730 to 1200 (Sunday) and is open throughout the year except on Christmas day.



owever payments at Sedudu Entrance Gate (Chobe National Park) and Two Rivers (Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park) are permitted and these offices operate within park opening and closing times and are open throughout the year.

We accept visa and mastercard for payment of park fees at all the above mentioned places except Two Rivers.
